



The Colorado Horse Park Eventing Derby

Friday, September 15th, 2017

The Colorado Horse Park is pleased to offer an Eventing Derby on Friday, September 15th, 2017. This jumping course consists of both show jumps and cross-country fences set on varied terrain. There will be 10 – 16 jumping efforts for each level that include water, cross country fences and stadium jumps. This will be an excellent opportunity for riders to school their horses the day before our Horse Trials begin.

And a chance to make some money. We will be running Intro, Beginner Novice, Novice and Training levels. Horse and rider will be judged at optimum time. The prize money for each level will be \$500, plus a \$25 add back per entry. The entry price for each horse and rider will be \$75, including the \$25 add back. Rider and horse combination may only enter two consecutive divisions. The split for the prize money as well as ribbons will be through 6th place: 1st place 25%, 2nd place 20%, 3rd place 17%, 4th place 15%, 5th place 13% and 6th place 10%.

At the end of the day, for all you non-riders, riders without a horse, mothers, fathers, etc. we will have a Hobby Horse division at the Intro level. Please bring your own stick horse. Details and entry form to follow.

A SEPARATE ENTRY MUST BE FILLED OUT FOR EACH HORSE

CHP Eventing Derby Intro: Maximum height 2'0, Speed 300 m/m, approximately 10 obstacles, water optional.

CHP Eventing Derby Beginner Novice: Maximum height 2'7, Speed 325 m/m, approximately 11 obstacles, water mandatory.

CHP Eventing Derby Novice: Maximum height 2'11, Speed 350 m/m, approximately 12 obstacles, water mandatory.

CHP Eventing Derby Training: Maximum height 3'3, Speed 375 m/m, approximately 13 obstacles, water mandatory.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition to the following:

I AGREE that "the Federation" and "Competition" as used herein includes the Licensee and Competition Management, as well as all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and Federation affiliates.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death. ("Harm").

I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Federation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition.

I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment, including GR801 and, if applicable, EV114, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries.

If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf.

I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition.

I AGREE that if I am injured at this competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to the Federation on the official USEF accident/injury report form.

Warning: Under Colorado law, an equestrian professional is not liable for an injury to, or death of a participant in equine activities, pursuant to section 13-21-120 Colorado Revised Statutes.
