



# **The Colorado Horse Park Eventing Derby**

**Saturday April 28 and Sunday September 23, 2018**

The Colorado Horse Park is pleased to offer two Eventing Derby's this season, first on Saturday, April 28, 2018 and again on Sunday, September 23, 2018. An Eventing Derby consists of a dressage test and a modified jumping course. The dressage test is 2018 USEF Test A, for Intro and also BN Test A. This jumping course consists of both show jumps and cross country fences set on varied terrain. There will be 10 – 16 jumping efforts for each level that include water, cross country fences and stadium jumps. If you are riding the 2 phase, \$250 will be split between 1<sup>st</sup> – 6 places and ribbons will be given out 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> places for each level. This Eventing Derby will follow the USEA rules for combined tests as closely as possible. If you choose to ride just one phase, either Dressage or Jumping, ribbons will be given out for each phase, 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> places. Extra Jump rounds will be available at the end of each division but will not be eligible for a ribbon. This will be an excellent opportunity for riders to school their horses and have fun as well.

The entire competition will be held on the cross country side of the road. Parking will be at the western arena complex, Gate 3.

For Biosecurity the following is required per stated on the CHP website:

- A Current negative coggins test certificate.
- A health certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian within 10 days of arrival at CHP.
- A list of vaccinations within 180 days of arrival including EHV 1&4. This can also be listed on the health certificate, which is preferable.

When entering the parking lot at gate 3, please have all biosecurity papers ready to show biosecurity person before taking your horse off the trailer. This year there will be no pre-check.

CHP Eventing Derby Intro: Maximum height 2'0, Speed 300 m/m, approximately 10 obstacles, water optional.

CHP Eventing Derby Beginner Novice: Maximum height 2'7, Speed 325 m/m, approximately 11 obstacles, water mandatory.

CHP Eventing Derby Novice: Maximum height 2'11, Speed 375 m/m, approximately 12 obstacles, water mandatory.

CHP Eventing Derby Training: Maximum height 3'3, Speed 400 m/m, approximately 13 obstacles, water mandatory.

CHP Eventing Derby Preliminary: Maximum height 3'7", Speed 425 m/m, approximately 14 obstacles, water mandatory.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death. ("Harm").

I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Federation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition.

I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment, including GR801 and, if applicable, EV114, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries.

If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf.

I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition.

I AGREE that if I am injured at this competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to the Federation on the official USEF accident/injury report form.
