



THE SPECTATOR'S GUIDE

To Equestrian Competition

HUNTER/JUMPER HORSE SHOWS

A Hunter/Jumper horse show is a three to five-day event made up of many mini-events that take place in the show rings each day, called classes. There are three main class categories: Show Jumpers, Hunters, and Equitation. Classes are further subdivided by rider age and experience level, skill of the horse, size or age of the horse or pony, etc., all of which determine what size and type of a fence the horses and riders will jump.

HUNTERS

Hunt seat competitions are based upon elegant traditions arising from the foxhunt. Hunters differ from Jumpers because they are judged on the style, movement, and technical proficiency of the horse and rider within the constraints of the set course design. Hunters should display jumping ability, manners, style, an even pace, and quality.



FEI

Fédération Équestrian Internationale (FEI) is based in Lausanne, Switzerland and is the governing body for all Olympic equestrian disciplines.

GRAND PRIX SHOW JUMPING

Jumping is the best-known and is also one of the three Olympic equestrian sports, along with Dressage and Eventing. As in all equestrian sports, men and women compete on equal terms. Grand Prix Show Jumping is the highest and most challenging level of Jumping competition. Riders compete over a set course of obstacles as tall as 1.60 meters (5.25 feet) in height. They must clear all of the fences without knocking down a rail and within the time allowed in order to return for the second round, also known as the "jump-off," and be the fastest with the least faults to win.



GUIDE TO SHOW JUMPING SCORING

Penalties in Show Jumping competitions are referred to as "faults." Knocking down a rail or pole on a jump is 4 faults, as is the first refusal at a fence. Falls and going off-course result in elimination, as does a second refusal.

Show Jumping Faults and Penalties:

Knocking over a jump or rail: 4 faults
Refusing a jump: 4 faults
Two Refusals OR Rider Fall: Eliminated
Time Allowed: 1 fault for every second or portion thereof over the designated time allowed

CONCOURS DE SAUT INTERNATIONAL - CSI

CSI is the ranking system for Show Jumping. CSI is broken down into a starring system, with higher prize money the higher number of stars: e.g. CSI 5* prize money is over \$300,000.

EVENTING

Eventing, one of the three Olympic equestrian disciplines, is a formidable combination of Dressage, Cross-Country, and Show Jumping, done over two or three days and with the same horse for each phase of competition. Often known as the triathlon of the equestrian world, Eventing is a sport that tests both the horse and rider in all aspects of horsemanship and athleticism.



CONCOURS DE DRESSAGE INTERNATIONAL-CDI

CDI notes the ranking system for Dressage with the same starring system as for Show Jumping.



PARA-DRESSAGE

Para-Dressage is conducted under the same basic rules as conventional Dressage, but with riders divided into different competition grades based on functional abilities. There is no greater evidence of the incredible bond, trust and communication between horse and rider than in Para-Dressage. This Paralympic sport is a humbling reminder of the strength of the human spirit.



DRESSAGE

Dressage is a competitive equestrian sport, defined by the Federation Equestrian International (FEI) as "the highest expression of horse training." The rider will be relaxed and appear effort-free while the horse willingly performs the requested movement. In modern Dressage competition, successful training at the various levels is demonstrated through the performance of "tests," which include a prescribed series of movements ridden within a standard arena. The Freestyle is specially choreographed and performed to music.

DRIVING

Like the sport of Eventing, but with a horse-drawn carriage, the sport of Driving tests a handler's skills over three phases - Dressage, Marathon, and Cones - in Singles, Pairs, and Four-in-hand divisions. This sport demands horse-and-driver communication, finesse, and teamwork through three challenging phases of competition.



MOUNTED GAMES

Often set up in relay race formats, this fast-paced sport emphasizes horsemanship, balanced riding, teamwork, precision, and speed! Mounted Games events usually feature but are not limited to junior riders and ponies. From balloon popping to egg-and-spoon relays or pole bending, horse-and-rider pairs need to work together through multiple tests to come out on top.



EQUITATION

Equitation competition is offered for junior and amateur riders and is judged based on the style and form of the rider. Horses are not judged in this discipline, but successful riders will ensure that their horses are well behaved. Riders can be judged over fences or on the flat.
