I **AGREE** in consideration for my participation, attendance, and/or stabling at the Tryon International Equestrian Center (TIEC), to the following:

I **AGREE** that the TIEC and "participation" as used above includes all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations. I **AGREE** that I choose to participate voluntarily in events at TIEC with my horse, or as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, ag coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior participant. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse and these events involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including brok bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death. ("Harm")

I **AGREE** to hold harmless and release the TIEC from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arise results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the TIEC.

I **AGREE** to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the TIEC.

I **AGREE** to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the TIEC and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at any event. I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without prejudice or penalty, and I acknowledge that I am strongly encouraged to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. If I am a parent or guardian of a child participant, I consent to the child's participation and **AGREE** to all of the above provisions and **AGREE** to assume all of the obligations of this Form on the child's behalf. I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely participate and/or attend these events.
