

Stop #9: Shops & Boutiques

From Legends Plaza, travel west to The Promenade featuring a diverse collection of shops and boutiques selling gifts, merchandise, and resort services. Start with Tryon Resort's own Unique Boutique with entrances in both Legends Plaza and The Promenade and make your way from cabin 1 through cabin 15 shopping for treasures along the way. Stop #10: Silo Bar

At the end of the Promenade, behind Ring 4, discover the Silo Bar. Built from a true grain silo, this unique bar is the best spot for late-night fun, especially on Friday and Saturday nights following competition. The collection of hammocks also make it a nice place to relax during the day.

Stop #11: The Grand Hunter Ring & Rings 1-4 Located alongside the Promenade shops and boutiques are Rings 1 through 4 where a majority of competitions take place. The Grand Hunter Ring is designated in Ring 4.

Stop #12: The Barns

On the west side of the Silo Bar you will find Barns 1-5. TIEC is equipped with seven outdoor barns in all with a total 1,200 stalls, plus an additional 200 stalls located inside the Indoor Arena. Designed by MDBarnmaster, the barns feature fans and lockable tack rooms with proximity to several permanent and air conditioned bathrooms.


Stop #13: Bridle Path Back to Legends Plaza Conclude your tour by following the path from Barn 4 to Barn 1 where you will see our property-wide bridlepath offering close and convenient access to the rings. At Barn 1, turn right and take the sidewalk next to the golf cart path back to Legends Plaza.

Welcome to Tryon International Equestrian Center & Resort (TIEC) - the ultimate destination for all who love horses, outdoor living, and an active lifestyle. Explore our grounds and learn more about us by following this self-guided walking tour.

Stop #1: Legends Plaza - The Carousel

You cannot enter Legends
Plaza without seeing the handpainted Venetian carousel that
adorns the entrance. This
iconic structure was installed
at the onset of construction in
2014 as a reminder to everyone
that our love for horses often
begins in the innocence of our
childhood imaginations. The
carousel at TIEC typically runs
on weekends and is always free
and open to the public to ride.

Stop #2: Legends Plaza - The Restaurants

Legends Plaza is the hub of TIEC! Here, you will find our spacious plaza anchored by several restaurants including Blue Ginger Sushi, Legends Grille, Campagna Italian Cuisine and Roger's Diner. For a quick bite in Legends Plaza, you can visit Jennifer's Creamery or The General Store, where inside you can order from Starbucks or the Pony Express Deli or grab to-go items from the cooler. For menus and hours of operation, visit Tryon.com/Dining.

Stop #3: Welcome Center Stop by the Tryon Resort Welcome Center located across from Campagna Italian Cuisine to pick up a visitor guide, a resort map, area info, or to ask questions when volunteers are present to assist.



Stop #4: International Pavilion

The signature three-story International Pavilion was first used for the 2018 FEI World Equestrian Games and boasts expansive views of both Tryon Stadium and the International Stadium. On the first floor join our CrossFit gym and rec center. The second floor has space for smaller events, while the third floor - The Ridge - is available to rent for larger functions, and is also used for Tryon Resort's premier VIP events.

Stop #5: International Stadium

Walk around the International Pavilion to find the International Stadium. In addition to a full calendar of equestrian events, this venue plays host to a diverse calendar of resort events such as bull riding, multi-day festivals, concerts and more. The 3,000-seat stands are covered providing a comfortable spectator experience.

Stop #6: Tryon Stadium

Next, walk just behind the Welcome Center where you will see the magnificent Tryon Stadium. With 3,500 seats, this is where TIEC hosts its largest competitions. In this ring you can regularly watch Olympic-level show jumping riders compete for top purses up to hundreds of thousands of dollars. Riders of all levels always relish the opportunity to compete in this state-of-the-art arena.

Stop #7: Legends Club

Legends Club is also located in Legends Plaza and provides covered, outdoor dining and seating in Tryon Stadium. Dinner buffets are often hosted during special events and competitions where seats can be reserved for a fee. No membership is needed for the Legends Club and the public is welcome to reserve tables or seats there for special events. When a special event is not being hosted in the Legends Club, guests are welcome to sit and watch at their leisure.

Stop #8: Legends Plaza - The Bronze Plaque

Be sure to stop by the bronze plaque hanging below the jumbotron screen in Legends Plaza. Here, you will see the names of the staff and contractors who were instrumental in the initial development of TIEC in 2014-2015.
