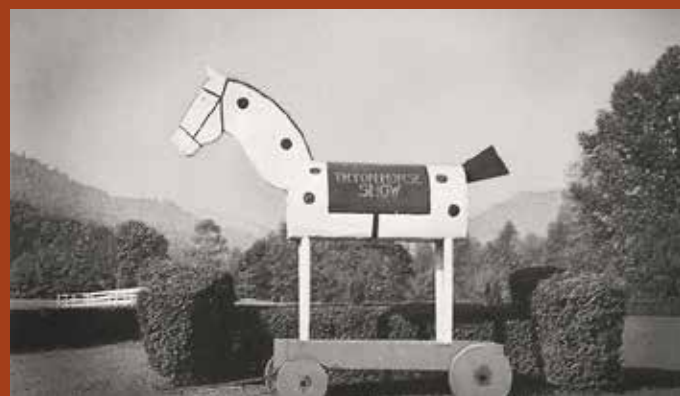
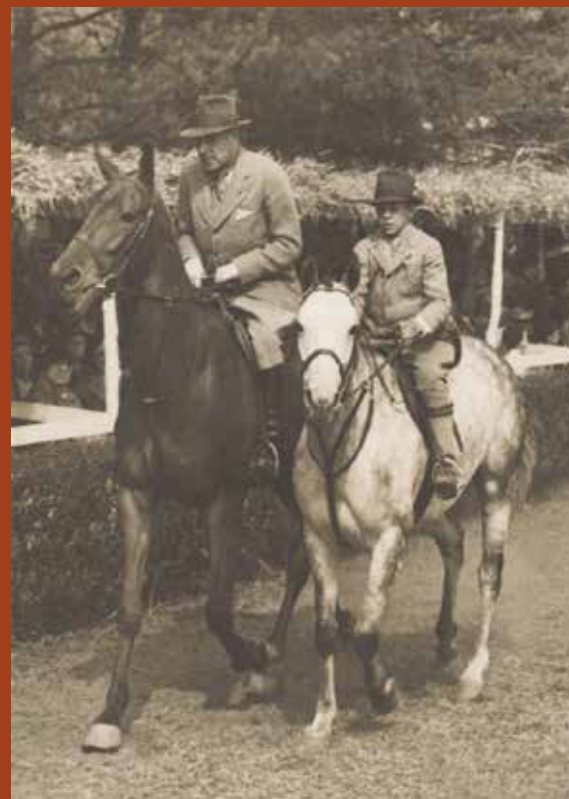

Hope Remains Ranch

Hope Remains Ranch, Spartanburg, SC, is an equine therapy program that positively channels the impact and influence horses have on humans. Hope Remains Ranch provides a Christ-centered environment of hope and healing for children, adults and families in our community by utilizing equine therapy, Biblically-based professional counseling and mentorship in life skills.

Horses help break down the walls that individuals have built which helps us get to the root of the problem that is being presented and more effectively solve the issue, and share that there is hope for them through Jesus Christ. According to Hope Remains Ranch, equine therapy is a non-judgmental experience that does not feel like therapy while providing a self-discovery solution versus a diagnosed solution using metaphors through the horses.

The Sanctuary at Red Bell Run

The Sanctuary at Red Bell Run, Columbus, NC is an equine sanctuary that includes housing and pastures for rescued equines from across the United States. A brainchild of Mary Adams, the Sanctuary accepts animals from law enforcement and other 501(c)3 rescues whose quality of life is still acceptable but who need more intensive or special care to remain comfortable. It is one of a few of its kind in the country, providing individualized care to over 100 equines. Red Bell Run works with several rescues across the US to take in equines who are considered un-adoptable or who need end of life care. Included among the equines sanctuaried at Red Bell Run are miniature hinnies, donkeys, and ponies as well as their larger brethren from horses to draft mules and even Mammoth donkeys. Each is considered as an individual and their care is overseen by their knowledgeable staff, farriers and veterinarians.

Nora Langhorne Flynn Trophy & Chinquapin Trophy

Nora Langhorne Flynn Trophy & Chinquapin Trophy Originally designated for champion Green Working Hunter division 1937 and donated by Nora Langhorne Flynn, it was quickly retired by Chinquapin Farm in 1940 after their entries won in three consecutive years. The Mahler family graciously donated the unique twelve-sided cup back to the club for use as a perpetual trophy for the Junior Hunter division. Also donated by the Mahler family and currently known as the Chinquapin Trophy, the Count Cadence was awarded to the champion in the Amateur Owner Stake class from 1967-1973. Today it is presented to the champion of the Amateur Owner Hunter Division.

Jane Raoul Bingham Trophy

First awarded in 1938-1942 (no horse show was held from 1943-1945 because of the war), the last year the trophy was engraved was for Chuck Haywood in 1947. No jumper classes were offered in 1949-1954, but when Class 11 Open Jumpers returned in 1955, the class description read: "To be shown over 8 jumps up to 4' taken in any order the exhibitor pleases." It returned to a more specific format in the following years. This trophy became the award for the champion of the Children's/Adult's Jumper division in 2004.

Barbara Jimenez Memorial Trophy

Barbara Jimenez was a local equestrian who passed away in 2006 from ovarian cancer. A lifelong animal lover she was an unfailing sportsman and avid competitor. The trophy is awarded to the Adult Hunter Circuit Champion. Local artist Phyllis Eifert created and donated the stunning bronze in her memory.

Betty Reynolds Oare Trophy

A Chippendale plate originally awarded to the winner of the Horsemanship (Equitation) 13-18 class, Betty Reynolds was the first recorded winner in 1959. Her lasting impression on the Town of Tryon prompted the renaming of the trophy in her honor. Today it is awarded to the Junior Rider who accumulates the most points in the national and North Carolina Equitation classes at the Charity I Horse Show.

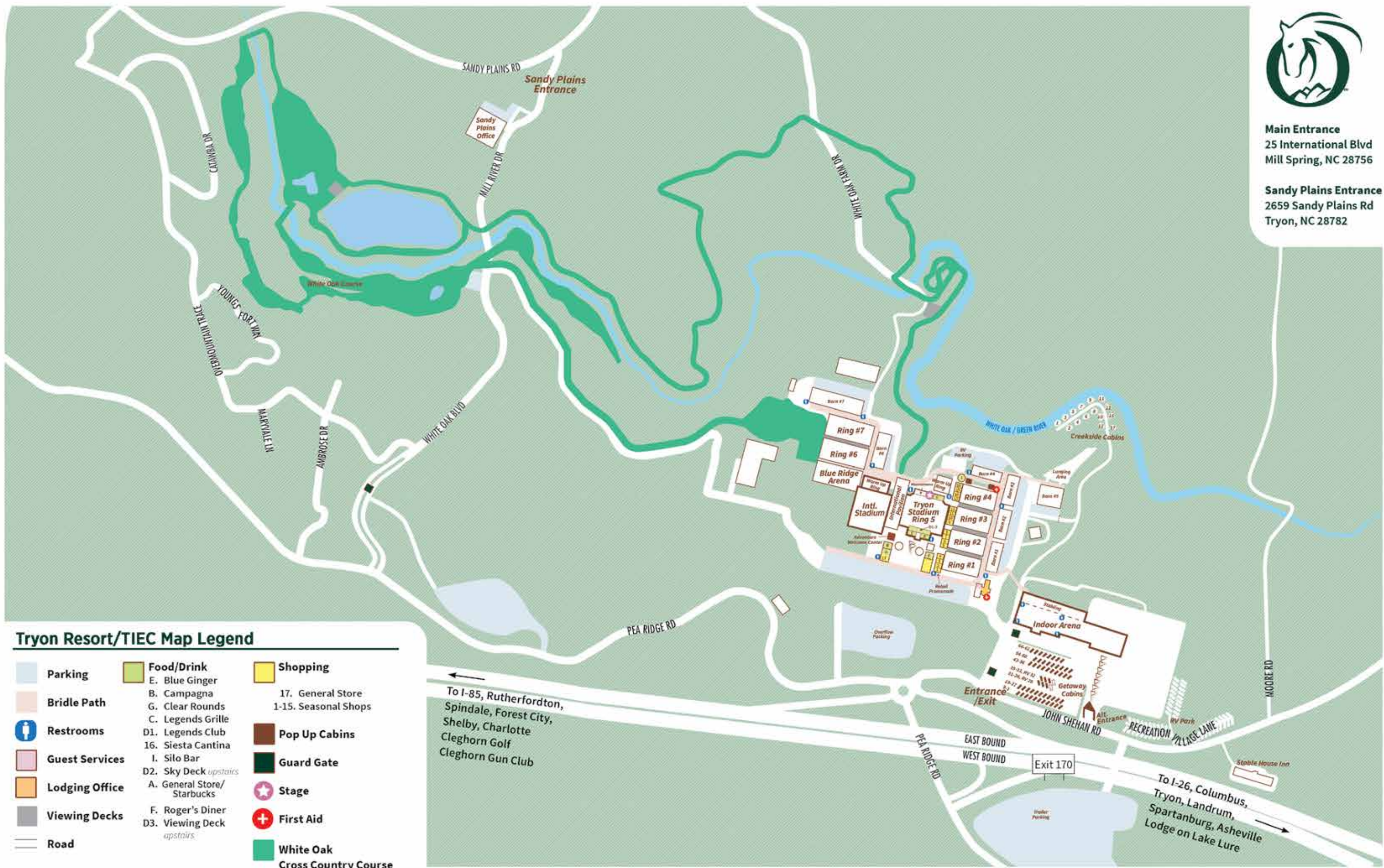
