## CAROLINAS SHOW HUNTER HALL OF FAME 2022 INDUCTEES



LEE 01994

**ALL MINE** was an extremely successful Large Junior Hunter. He was a bay Thoroughbred gelding that in the early 1990s was owned by the Roger Young Stables of Camden, SC, and ridden by Holly Hayes, nee Orlando. Holly said, "I only rode 'Monty' at the shows. Sometimes we'd get in a jump school beforehand. He was a big, brave, scopey horse that I just had to sit chilly on and let him do his job." At home she recalls that Roger was the only one that rode Monty. He'd hack him out on the trails in a big western saddle, no ring work or jumping, that was their routine. In 1992, All Mine was Champion and Grand Champion in the Large Junior Hunters at the PNHS, Champion at the NHS, and Reserve Champion at the WIHS. In 1993, he was Champion and Grand Champion Large Junior Hunter at the NHS, as well as Reserve Champion at the WIHS. After his career with Orlando ended, All Mine was sold to Shady Side Farm in Memphis, TN, where Neely Bates took over the ride. With Bill Schaub as their trainer, they successfully competed in the Junior Hunter division a year, and then the Younger Amateur Owner Hunter division before he was retired in 1998. Throughout his career, All Mine amassed 8,587 USEF points in the Junior Hunter division. All Mine spent his retirement years with Bates' other famous Junior Hunter Charade. "The two were turned out together and were like Frick and Frack," joked Shady Farm manager Nick Bishop, "they were competing for the title of most spoiled horse in the country."

**CHARADE** was a registered Appendix Quarter Horse foaled in Florida in 1985. He started his show hunter career with Nardeen Henderson and Peg Seals in VA in 1991. In 1992, he won many championships in the VA and MD area and ended the year as Second Year Green Hunter Reserve Champion at the WIHS. In 1993, he was purchased by Bud and Jean Rae Holmberg for their daughter Helen, and moved to their Fox Knoll Farm in Southern Pines, NC. Under the training of Don Stewart, he went on to many wins in the Small Junior Hunter division with Helen, and the Regular Working Hunter division with Scott Hofstetter. In 1993, in the Regular Working Hunter division, he was Reserve Champion at the PNHS, and, in the Small Junior Hunter division, he was Champion at the WIHS, and Reserve Champion at the NHS, winning the stake class at all three shows. In 1994, he was Regular Working Hunter Champion at Duke Children's, and the Winter Equestrian Festival (WEF) in Wellington, FL. Charade was also Small Junior Hunter Champion at Raleigh Indoors and Reserve Champion in the Small Junior Hunter division at Suncoast International in Tampa. In 1995, he was sold to Neely Bates and continued his winning career with Neely in both the Junior and Amateur Owner Hunter divisions. From 1995 to 1999 he racked up wins at shows all over NC, SC, FL, TN, KY, MI, OH, CT, MD, PA, DC, and NY. Highlights included being Small Junior Hunter Reserve Champion at Devon, Ox Ridge and Kentucky National Indoors. In 1998, he was Amateur Owner Hunter Champion or Reserve at both the Detroit and the Motor City Horse Shows, Ocala, Memphis, Brownland Farm, Charleston, Blowing Rock, Biltmore, and the WIHS. Among his many wins in 1999, he was the Amateur Owner Hunter Reserve Champion at Palm Beach Masters in Wellington, FL. Charade retired at the Bates' Farm in TN, where he lived out his life cared for by Nick Bishop, who had been his groom since December of 1992, when he first drove to VA to pick Charade up for the Holmbergs. Charade passed away at 32 years of age, Neely said, "He never had a bad day in his life."

**LYPHARD CAY** was a Thoroughbred, bred and foaled at Fairview Farms in Landrum, SC, in 1983. Tony Wallace, head trainer at Fairview Farm, sent him to Dave Kelly as a four-year-old, recognizing he would make a better show horse than race horse. Tim Grubb started him in the First Year Green Working Hunter division for then owner Marilla Van Beuren. Dave Kelly then persuaded Sherry Robertson to buy him in a deal she could not refuse. Early on she had Michael Matz ride him in the jumpers, but he had a difficult lead change. Using what Sherry called "the Dave Kelly technique," Sherry was able to finish the change herself, and after that he was never ridden by anyone else again. Sherry said, "I saved all the jumps for me, he was the best one I ever had. If you did not miss you were the winner." Nicknamed 'Piggy' for how he enjoyed making a mess in his stall, Sherry reported that he was quite the character; he could be mean on the ground but once you got on him he was all business. Sherry said, "He never needed a warmup class, never stopped, and loved to go to horse shows. He was my Idle Dice." Highlights of his Amateur Owner career included Champion or Reserve at the 1992 PNHS and the NHS, 1993 Champion at the WIHS and NHS and 1995 Champion and Grand Champion at Devon. He was Champion at the Autumn Classic, Cleveland Hunter Jumper Classic, Garden State, Greater Cincinnati Classic, Lake Placid, Tampa, and two-time WEF Circuit Champion. In 1997 Lyphard Cay's last show was at WEF, where true to his style he won a class. According to Sherry, "He was never formally retired. He spent his retirement at my farm in Edgemont, PA ... living like a show horse, turned out each day and groomed when he came in."

**NAUTE MIA** as a five year old was owned and shown by Miss Jean Cochrane. In 1951 he was Young Hunter Champion at the prestigious 46th Annual Piping Rock Horse Show in New York, as well as at Greenwich, Ox Ridge, and Fairfield. In 1955, then owned by Jarret Schmid's Saxon Woods Farm, he was Working and Conformation Hunter Champion at the Boulder Brook Horse Show with Schmid in the irons. Gordon Wright was the trainer and occasionally shared the ride with Schmid. In 1956 Jarret Schmid purchased J. Arthur Reynolds property on Hunting Country Road in Tryon, NC, as a winter home, renaming it Saxon Woods Farm. In 1960 Jarrett Schmid took up permanent residency in Tryon and brought her horses with her, continuing to ride and show Naute Mia. He was retired, after winning 43 championships and 222 blue ribbons, at a formal ceremony at the WIHS in 1962. Included in those championships were Working Hunter Championship titles at the PNHS, NHS at Madison Square Garden, and Toronto. Jarrett was said to have enjoyed hilltopping Naute Mia during his retirement.

### CAROLINAS SHOW HUNTER HALL OF FAME

#### Our Purpose

The purpose of Tryon Riding & Hunt Club's Carolinas Show Hunter Hall of Fame (CSHHF) is to recognize and promote exceptional show hunters and horsemen from North and South Carolina. Each year current CSHHF supporters show their appreciation and admiration of great horses, ponies and people by nominating and voting for those worthy of induction. Horses, ponies and horsemen are then inducted and celebrated at an annual ceremony. Donations and sponsorships enable the Hall of Fame to honor the inductees by creating an exhibit that showcases and memorializes the great history of these distinguished horses and horsemen.

#### About the CSHHF

For the Love of Hunters ... The Carolinas Show Hunter Hall of Fame had a casual and unpretentious beginning. One evening in October 2016, Gerald Pack of Columbus, NC, and Jack Towell of Camden, SC, ran into each other at *The Hare and Hound* in Landrum, SC. They began reminiscing about all the great show hunters and horsemen from the Tryon area. Their journey down memory lane soon became an endless list of famous horses and horsemen from all over the Carolinas. It was from that casual conversation among friendly horsemen that the Carolinas Show Hunter Hall of Fame was conceived and then grew to be a reality today.

#### TR&HC and CSHHF

Since 1925, Tryon Riding & Hunt Club (TR&HC) has been advancing its commitment to the Tryon equestrian community. Founded by Carter Brown, TR&HC has helped Tryon become one of the longest-standing equestrian communities in the country. Brown was dedicated to advancing the sport, and the activities he initiated have grown steadily through the work of TR&HC for 97 years. Some of the current TR&HC events include Tryon Block House Steeplechase, Charity I and II Horse Shows, Any and All Dog Show, TR&HC Fall Horse Trials, the TR&HC Horse and Hound Show, and the Carolinas Show Hunter Hall of Fame. By taking CSHHF under its wing, TR&HC continues to further its mission of encouraging, supporting and promoting horse activities that will enhance the equestrian tradition.

#### MERLIN'S MAGIC

Merlin's Magic was a striking dapple grey gelding, owned and was ridden by Jennifer Smith of Green Creek, NC. He was a Warmblood/Thoroughbred cross, purchased by Jennifer as a green broke three year old. Jennifer trained him herself with the assistance of Brad Spragg of the Atlanta Hunt Club and then Jack and Liza Towell of Finally Farm in Camden, SC. Liza remembers Jennifer and Merlin's Magic as having a great partnership and being very successful. Merlin's Magic was champion or reserve all over the Southeast in the Adult Amateur Hunter division. With limited showing from 2001-2003, he was champion or reserve 13 times. Merlin's Magic, a beautiful mover, not only won over fences but many under saddle classes. In 2004, he was champion or reserve at 6 consecutive horse shows, one being the Tryon Riding & Hunt Club Charity horse show, where he was Grand Champion Adult Amateur Hunter. Jennifer remembers scoring a 92 in one class at a show in Conyers, Georgia, her highest score ever. As she walked out of the ring one of her classmates said, "I'm not sure why you got a 92, that a should have been a 100." During his career, Merlin's Magic won classes in Ocala and Wellington with over 35 entries in each class. "Nick", as he is known around the barn, was retired in 2007 at the Smith's Green River Farm in Green Creek, NC.

#### Janet Peterson Memorial Trophy

The Janet Peterson trophy recognizes those who have made a substantial contribution to the sport of show hunters.





#### MARIE M. REYNOLDS

Marie M. Reynolds was an active presence in the show hunter world for over 30 years. She lived in Dobson, NC, at Long Creek Farm, and then moved to Southern Pines where she made her home at The Paddock for the last 20 years of her life with her husband Josh and a host of horses and dogs. Marie was an avid and successful horsewoman, as both an owner and rider. Marie won in the Amateur Owner Hunters at top competitions including the National Horse Show at Madison Square Garden and The Forum in Los Angeles, California. Additionally, she won at all of the Carolinas shows including the TR&HC Charity Horse Show first at Harmon Field and then at FENCE. Among her most successful show hunters were War Apple, Puddlejumper, Ninth Wave, Sunshot, Snicklefritz, Homegrown, and Cat Can Do. In 1993, while fighting a courageous battle with cancer, she continued riding and finished 2nd overall in the NCHJA standings. Marie passed away in January 1994. Her farm, The Paddock, was a haven for many of the nation's top horsemen including Katie Prudent, Don Stewart, Ronnie Beard, Gigi Gaston, and a host of young riders. According to Burr Collier, Marie was "not only a great horsemen...she was an inspiration to many and made an indelible impact on everyone fortunate enough to know her." Marie was a generous supporter of horse shows, including but not limited to Blowing Rock, Keswick, and The National. Almost 25 years after her death, The Richard J. Reynolds and Marie M. Reynolds Foundation continues to make a positive impact on the sport of show hunters in the Carolinas. Their foundation has made several substantial gifts to the Blowing Rock Charity Horse Show Foundation as well as a gift to The Aiken Horse Park Foundation (Bruce's Field). According to Cathy Schlaeppli, current Vice President of NCHJA, "Marie Reynolds was one of the nicest, most fascinating, funny women I have ever met. She and her horses were always beautifully turned out and amazing ... she was a great horsewoman."





## **Nora Langhorne Flynn Trophy & Chinquapin Trophy**

Nora Langhorne Flynn Trophy & Chinquapin Trophy Originally designated for champion Green Working Hunter division 1937 and donated by Nora Langhorne Flynn, it was quickly retired by Chinquapin Farm in 1940 after their entries won in three consecutive years. The Mahler family graciously donated the unique twelve-sided cup back to the club for use as a perpetual trophy for the Junior Hunter division. Also donated by the Mahler family and currently known as the Chinquapin Trophy, the Count Cadence was awarded to the champion in the Amateur Owner Stake class from 1967-1973. Today it is presented to the champion of the Amateur Owner Hunter Division.

## **Jane Raoul Bingham Trophy**

First awarded in 1938-1942 (no horse show was held from 1943-1945 because of the war), the last year the trophy was engraved was for Chuck Haywood in 1947. No jumper classes were offered in 1949-1954, but when Class 11 Open Jumpers returned in 1955, the class description read: "To be shown over 8 jumps up to 4' taken in any order the exhibitor pleases." It returned to a more specific format in the following years. This trophy became the award for the champion of the Children's/Adult's Jumper division in 2004.

## **Barbara Jimenez Memorial Trophy**

Barbara Jimenez was a local equestrian who passed away in 2006 from ovarian cancer. A lifelong animal lover she was an unfailing sportsman and avid competitor. The trophy is awarded to the Adult Hunter Circuit Champion. Local artist Phyllis Eifert created and donated the stunning bronze in her memory.

## **Betty Reynolds Oare Trophy**

A Chippendale plate originally awarded to the winner of the Horsemanship (Equitation) 13-18 class, Betty Reynolds was the first recorded winner in 1959.

Her lasting impression on the Town of Tryon prompted the renaming on the trophy in her honor.

Today it is awarded to the Junior Rider who accumulates the most points in the national and North Carolina Equitation classes at the Charity I Horse Show.
