

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the Tryon Horse Shows ('Competition'). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

OWNERS, OFFICIALS, AND EMPLOYEES WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ACCIDENT OR LOSS WHICH MAY OCCUR TO ANY EXHIBITOR SPECTATOR, GUEST, RIDER, GROOM, ATTENDANT OR OTHER EMPLOYEE, ANIMAL, VEHICLE OR EQUIPMENT AT THE SHOW. THIS SHALL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY TO THE SHOW OR SHOW GROUNDS.

The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management, its decision to be final.

Management reserves the right to limit entries in any class, section or division, to refuse, accept conditionally, or to

cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings and rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants. Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Show Management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of the horse show and the facilities at which the horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s) or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause. While every effort has been made to avoid mistakes in this publication, the USEF, Tryon Horse Shows, Tryon International Equestrian Center, Equus Events, Inc. and its management and/or employees assume no liability to anyone for errors. Any significant errors or changes will be disclosed to competitors whose entries are accepted upon their acceptance, and otherwise in accordance with USEF rules.

REMINDER: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the US Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the US Center SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

MICROCHIPS: All horses and ponies must be microchipped in order to be allowed to show. Exempt from this requirement are Walk-Trot and Opportunity entries and those others listed in USEF GR 901.

SCHEDULES: All Schedules are Tentative and subject to change. Updated schedules and daily schedules are available at www.tryon.com.

ENTRIES: Entries must be made online by the closing dates in order to avoid a late fee. Faxed, scanned and/or e-mailed entries will not be accepted.

CLOSING DATES for entries are as follows:

SUMMER 1 - June 13, 2022 SUMMER 2 - June 16, 2022 SUMMER 3 - June 14, 2022 SUMMER 4 - June 21, 2022 SUMMER 5 - June 28, 2022 SUMMER 6 - July 5, 2022

After the closing date stall fees are non-refundable. A \$50 Late Fee will apply for all entries not made online or postmarked by the closing dates. Scratches after the closing date will incur a \$60 Scratch Fee. Entries should be submitted via our online entry system at www.tryon.com or www.showgroundslive.com. EMAILED/SCANNED/FAXED ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Back numbers will not be issued without a signed open check drawn on a US bank or credit card information lodged with the Horse Show Secretary. A \$50 fee will be charged for non-negotiable checks or credit cards declined for any reason. A \$60 Office Fee will be charged to each horse to cover adds/scratches, office services, etc. All accounts must be closed out by Sunday of each show week unless prior arrangements have been made with the horse show secretary. The entry form for each horse must include the following:

- · Horse name and complete description
- Complete mailing addresses for owner/trainer/riders
- All mandatory signatures, including legal guardian in the case of a minor exhibitor
- All required organization membership numbers, USEF/USHJA horse registration numbers and microchip numbers
- Social Security or Federal ID number of owner or alternate prize money payee. No prize money will be applied until Tax ID#s and complete payee names/addresses/W-9's are on file with the Secretary. Prize money will be credited to your show account. Any overages will be mailed within 30 days of the close of the competition. In the event of unauthorized redeeming of a check, Tryon Horse Shows, LLC will provide check copies to exhibitors and will be held harmless from the collection process.
- All showing horses/ponies will be assessed a mandatory \$15 Ambulance Fee per competition
- Equine Night Security is included in the stall fee
- All riders participating in amateur or adult classes must be in possession of current amateur status issued by USEF, or apply for same at show
- Entries/post entries accepted based on stall availability; \$50 Late Fee

SCRATCHES: Horses may be scratched without a veterinarian's certificate by notifying the horse show secretary in writing. Prior to the closing date, all charges will be refunded. After the closing date, stalls are non-refundable and horses will be charged a \$60 scratch fee. No refunds to horses entered in classes not shown.

We encourage you to close out your account each week in person or online. If you do not, you automatically agree to authorize Tryon Horse Shows to charge your credit card or open check for all entry fees, stabling fees, association fees, etc. associated with your horse(s). If you dispute a charge made by Tryon Horse Shows, you may not be able to show until the dispute has been resolved.

STALLS: All stalls are non-transferable and remain under the ownership and control of Tryon International Equestrian Center. Permanent 10x12 stalls of wood/metal construction and temporary 10x10 stall of canvas/metal construction with doors. Flooring is rubber mats over stone dust. Stalls are available for \$225 during Summer 1 & 2 and \$300 for Summer 3-6. Locking tack stalls are also available at the regular stall price. Stalls are not refundable after the closing date. To ensure stabling as well as your initial bedding/feed orders, please complete an online entry at Tryon.com. Any horse showing in classes that fall under the '24 Hour Rule' must have an unshared, assigned stall and will be assessed a stall fee. Non-stabled horses will pay a \$50 Grounds Fee.

STABLING: Will be available starting at 1:00 pm the day before Schooling Day. Check schedules for Schooling Day. Any and all requests for early arrival/late departure must be approved by the Stabling Manager. Early arrivals/late departures will incur a charge of \$50 per stall per day (or any portion thereof).

FEI STALLS: Permanent 10x12 stalls of wood/metal construction. One stall per each FEI horse is included in the FEI Event Fee. Additional FEI stalls, if available, are \$350. FEI STABLING: Will be available as per FEI draft schedule. Any and all requests for early arrival/late departure must be approved by the Stabling Manager. Early arrivals/late departures will incur a charge of \$50 per stall per day (or any portion thereof). FEI - please refer to FEI page herein.

PHOTO RELEASE: By signing the entry form I agree to waive the right to the use of my photos/videos at the competition and grant Tryon Horse Shows, LLC, and its agents full use of any and all competition photos and videos. **PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR:** Protective headgear, properly secured, must be worn BY ALL RIDERS AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED, anywhere, anytime on the horse show grounds. Headgear for all riders must meet or exceed ASTM Standards: must carry the SEI tag; and be properly secured by a harness per USEF rules.

NON-SHOWING HORSES: All non-showing horses must have a signed entry blank on file in the office and will be

assigned a number. A \$50 Non-Showing Fee will be assessed to any horse not entered in any classes.

 $\bf SHARPS$ $\bf CONTAINERS:$ Sharps Containers are available in the barns.

TRAINER SPLITS: Trainer Splits are done as a courtesy and must be turned into the Horse Show Office by 12:00 noon on Friday. Any trainer accounts which have not been split, for any reason, will be evenly split on all horses entered into the horse show.

TICKETED SCHOOLING: If time and weather permits, management may make ticketed schooling available for \$30 per round. Back number and a signed entry blank are required. Time limits may apply. Switching riders or horses leaving and returning to the ring are susceptible to being billed for a second round.

MEASUREMENTS: Measurements will be conducted at 10am on Friday of each show. If an alternate measure time is needed, the exhibitor should schedule this in the show office.

LODGING: Please contact our Lodging Department at 828-863-1015 to inquire about available onsite/offsite lodging options, reserve a room, cabin or camper/RV site or golf cart. All reservations and payment for all reservations must be made directly to the Lodging Department. Campers/RVs/cabins, etc. may NOT be put on show bills, nor split on Trainer Accounts.

MINORS/MINOR EXHIBITORS: Parent(s) or quardian(s) of minors/minor exhibitors shall hold the Horse Show Management and the Facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No child's entry will be accepted or number issued unless the entry is signed by a parent or LEGAL guardian. The signature of unrelated persons WILL NOT be accepted. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian, or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hoverboards and single wheeled scooters are prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people

gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

RINGS: All competition/riding rings have all-weather footing that consists of sand and synthetic material mixture and draining system. Rings 1-4 178'x390' each; Tryon Stadium 310'x250'; Ring 6/7 370'x420', Ring 8 150'x691'; International Arena 260'x325'; Longeing Area 420'x115'.

COURSES: Management reserves the right to restrict the area of the courtesy circle, if deemed necessary, by a mandatory line ("dotted line") as per HU110.2.

DOGS: Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise contained at all times. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards pursuant to rule GR1301.6. Failure to maintain your dog under control, as defined here, will result in a \$100 fine assessed to the owner. In addition, pursuant to facility regulations, loose dogs will be removed from the show grounds by Animal Control, at the owner's expense and impounded.

PARKING: Fire regulations prohibit all vehicles, including trailers, vans and passenger vehicles from being parked in the stable areas. Vans and trailers will be allowed in the stable area only to load or off-load. PARKING AREAS WILL BE DESIGNATED AND VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AWAY AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.

ANIMAL WELFARE: We require that all horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion, and should never be subject to mistreatment. Owners, trainers, riders, and grooms or their agents must use reasonable care in the handling and treatment of their horses whether owned or placed in their care for competition or for any other purpose. At all times, while the horse is on the show grounds, we will provide for the continuous well-being of the horse by vigorously enforcing the rules of the USEF which pertain to the welfare of the horse. USEF rules defining policy regarding abuse and use of whips will be strictly enforced. No poling, use of bamboo off-set or excessive use of the whip will be tolerated. The well-being of the horse must be considered above the demands of the breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organizers, sponsors or officials. Violators may be subject to penalties pursuant to USEF rules. IN THE EVENT OF AN ACUTE AND SERIOUS INJURY TO OR ILLNESS OF A HORSE ON COMPETITION GROUNDS WHEN THE OWNER OR TRAINER OF THE HORSE OR AGENT OF THE OWNER IS NOT PRESENT, AFTER REASONABLE EFFORT TO CONTACT THAT INDIVIDUAL HAS BEEN MADE, COMPETITION MANAGEMENT,

IN CONSULTATION WITH A LICENSED EQUINE VETERINARIAN, MAY AUTHORIZE THE PROVISION OF EMERGENCY VETERINARY TREATMENT OF THE HORSE. IF COMPETITION MANAGEMENT SO AUTHORIZES TREATMENT UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS RULE, COMPETITION MANAGEMENT AND VETERINARIAN ARE NOT LIABLE FOR ANY RESULTING COSTS, DAMAGES, LOSSES, CLAIM OR ACTIONS ARISING DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY FROM THE TREATMENT OF THE HORSE.

ELECTRICAL/FIRE REGULATIONS: All electrical installation and connections must meet all state and county codes. Aisles will be maintained clear for a minimum of six (6) feet wide by eight (8) feet high. No obstructions or projections shall be allowed in the aisles. No Class 1 Flammable liquids such as gasoline are allowed inside the buildings. Cooking is not permitted within the stable area. 

Horse Rules and Regulations

A. Horse inspection and jog for soundness

- Championship horses must be stabled on the show grounds, in official horse show stabling, starting no later than 1 hour prior to the horse inspection and remaining on the show grounds until the completion of their Championship.
- Horses competing in the Championship may not compete in any other class at the same horse show after the Official Jog has taken place. Exception: Official Zone Jumper Team Championship Training class if offered.
- All Championship horses must be presented at the mandatory horse inspection by the athlete
 or designated representative. The horse inspection and jog for soundness will be held not
 more than 24 hours prior to the start of the First Individual Qualifying Class. The exact time
 and location will be included in the prize list and schedule for each championship.
- A designated representative other than the rider, who must be at least 18 years of age, may present at the horse inspection.
- Each horse must be presented with its entry number and current Coggins. Following the
 official horse inspection, the assigned back number must always accompany the horse when
 it is out of its stall and must be visible on the stall door when in the stall.
- Horses not accepted at the horse inspection and jog for soundness will have the opportunity to be re-presented once prior to the First Individual Qualifying Class.
- If a horse is not accepted at the initial horse inspection and jog for soundness, they may not
 participate in the Championship Training Session if it is held prior to the re-inspection. Horses
 not accepted at the re-inspection and jog for soundness will not be allowed to compete in the
 Championships. Horses may not participate in any concurrently held competition during which
 the Championship is held on the same grounds for a period of 48 hours following the horse
 inspection. (GR914.3)

B. Tack/Equipment

USEF Rules: USEF rules will govern these Championships. (JP 111). Additionally, please pay particular attention to the specifics listed below:

*Martingales

- Standing martingales are permitted in the 1.10/1.15m Children's and Adult Amateur Jumper Championship and the 1.20/1.25m Junior and Amateur Jumper Championships.
- The use of any other type of martingale will be cause for elimination from the Championship class. Exception: Irish Martingales may be used.

*The use of Draw Reins, German Martingales, Chambons, or any other unconventional equipment are not allowed at any time during the Championships, including schooling. Exception: The use of Draw Reins is permissible during Awards Presentations and Victory Gallops.

*Equipment

- Boot regulations-Refer to rule JP111.5.

Athlete Rules and Regulations

- Although an athlete is not prevented from competing on another horse during the Championship week, there will be no waiting for that athlete/horse during the Championship classes. If an athlete is not immediately available in the order, the athlete will be scratched from that Championship class.
- 2. Failure to enter the ring within one minute of being called incurs elimination. The time limit for entering the ring must be enforced by management. (JP136.2)
- 3. Only the competing athlete may be mounted on the Championship horse after the official jog.
- 4. Rider's Meeting: There will be a **mandatory** rider's meeting and Show Jumping Athlete Pathway Orientation presentation: time and location will be included in the prize list and schedule.
- 5. The draw for the Team Order of Go **may** take place at the Riders Meeting.
- 6. Teams will be determined two weeks prior to the Championship and are subject to change should a member of a team scratch. All necessary changes will be communicated to the Zone Chefs d'Equipe.
- 7. To hold a Zone Jumper Team Championship, a minimum of three teams must be entered in each section or combined section. Teams may be combined by sections or height, and/or combined section, height, and zone.

A. Schooling

USEF Jumper Schooling Rules will be in effect *throughout the competition (JP 103) and Appendix A* Attire (JP111.9)

B. Attire

- 1. Official Horse Inspection and Jog for Soundness and Course Walks
 - Athletes and or designated representatives must be appropriately dressed. Athletes must
 wear boots, breeches, and a hard hat. A designated representative must be professionally
 dressed with proper footwear for the Official Horse Inspection and Jog for Soundness,
 Please refer to USEF Rule JP 111.9c

2. First Individual Qualifier and Team Competition

- White breeches: Zone team shirts or team polo shirts are encouraged. Shirts must have collars and sleeves (sleeves may be either long or short) and must be tucked into breeches. Sleeveless shirts and shirts with exposed hoods are prohibited. If team shirts are not available athletes must follow the Formal Attire dress code. (JP 111.9a)
- Members on each team must all wear coordinated shirts or formal attire. Boots are required. Half chaps are permitted *if* the color matches the paddock boot.

3. Individual Final

Formal Attire required. Dark, muted, or similar colored coats are required; white breeches; a white tie, choker (unless the shirt, by design, has the choker built in for its intended use) and a white shirt must be worn. Shirts must be fastened at the neck and tucked into breeches. Boots are required. Half chaps are permitted if the color matches the paddock boots being worn. (JP111.9a)

OPTION ONE Three Day / Three Round Format

- A. Day One (First Round of the Team Championship and First Individual Qualifying Class)
 - 1. Specifications: The class will be conducted under a Table II, Section 1. Faults and Time. (*JP* 146.2) The results of this class will be decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the time allowed. Horses with clear rounds or equal faults are classified according to their time taken to complete the course. Athletes eliminated 2022 Zone Jumper Team Championship Specifications 5 or retiring from the course, for any reason, shall receive 20 faults more than the highest penalized competitor in that round *who completed the course and received a score.*
 - 2. Individual Classification: Faults **and time** from Round One will be carried forward to the Individual Standings.
 - 3. The order of the individuals on a team will be determined by the Chefs and given to the USHJA representative at the Rider's Meeting. **Teams of three will start with their first rider in the second rotation.**
 - 4.Only the top three team member scores from Round One will count toward the team score on Round Two.
 - 5.Class Awards: Ribbons will be awarded through 8th place. Prize money: 20% of the sections prize money will be paid through 8th as follows: 30%, 22%, 15%, 10%, 7%, 6%, 5%, 5%.
- B. Day Two (Second Round of the Team Championship/Second Individual Qualifying Class)
 - Specifications: The Team Championship is a two round format held over two days. Round two
 also serves as the second Qualifying Class for the Individual Final. The competitors will be
 scored under a modified Table II.

Scoring

- The Second Round of the Team Championship is open only to athlete/horse combinations that have started (whether eliminated or not) in the First Individual Qualifying Class (Day One). Athletes eliminated or retiring from the course for any reason shall receive a score equal to 20 faults more than that received by the highest penalized competitor in that round. Only the **top** three scores of each team from **rounds one and two** will count toward the team's **final** score. The winning team will be the team with the lowest combined scores from the two rounds. Any teams tied for a medal shall jump-off. The Chefs d'Equipe will select one member from the team for the jump off. If jump-offs for multiple medals are required, the jump-off or the lowest medal will occur first. Placing of teams tied below medal positions will be decided by the combined times from the three highest place riders on a team from Day One.
- Start Order: The starting order of teams will be the reverse order of team scores from the first round (Day One). Any teams tied will go in the order of their first round drawn order.
- Athletes competing as individuals will compete in drawn order in the first round and first
 in the second round of the Team Competition. The second-round order for Individual
 competitors will be based on reverse order of scores from the first round.
- Class Awards: Medals will be awarded to the gold, silver, and bronze teams, ribbons will be awarded through 3rd place, along with any trophy or other prizes that management chooses to award. Gold team must ride for ribbons, silver and bronze teams will enter the ring on foot

for a podium presentation. Prize money: 15% of the section's prize money will be paid to the Gold, Silver and Bronze winning teams. Prize money will be paid through 3rd as follows: 50%, 30%, 20%, and divided equally among the team's members. Additionally, ribbons will be awarded through 8th to the individual class placings after round one and round two of Team Competition. Prize money: 15% of the sections prize money will be paid through 8th to the individual class placings. After round two of **the Individual Qualifier** follows: 30%, 22%, 15%, 10%, 7%, 6%, 5%, 5%. **Only faults from the 2nd Individual Qualifier will be considered.** Ties for individual placing will be broken by the time from Day One.

C. DayThree (IndividualFinal)

Specifications: The competition will conclude with the Individual Final on the third day. It will be scored under Table II Section 2 and held over one round. The top **15** athlete/horse combinations 2022 Zone Jumper Team Championship Specifications 6 based on the cumulative scores from the first and second individual qualifying classes, including ties for 15th place, are eligible to compete. They must have not been eliminated in either of the two rounds of the competition. The list of the top 15 will be posted and distributed as soon as feasible after the Team Competition concludes and medals are awarded. Following this posting, if one or more of the qualified athlete/horse combinations is unable to start in the Individual Final, the combination will not be replaced.

- Start Order: The start order will be the reverse order of a rider's total scores incurred in the
 first and second individual qualifying classes. In the event of equality of scores, the result of
 the first qualifying class will decide, with a lower placing athlete/horse combination going
 before a higher placing competitor.
- Jump-Off: In the case of a tie for an individual medal, there will be a jump-off. Competitors
 will jump-off in the same start order of the Individual Final. If jump-offs for multiple
 medals are required, the jump-off for the bronze medal will occur first.
- Class Awards: Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals provided by the USHJA will be awarded to the top three individuals, along with ribbons to 8th and other specified prizes or prize money as may be specified by the organizers and the USHJA. Top 3 overall must ride for ribbons. Gold, Silver, and Bronze Individuals must stay for a podium presentation. Prize money: 50% of the sections prize money will be paid to medal winning individuals as follows: Gold 50%, Silver 30%, Bronze 20 %.
- The Individual Medalists are invited to participate in one of the USHJA Gold Star clinics. Wild
 Card applications will be considered. Please find the most updated information about the
 USHJA Gold Star Clinics at: ushja.org/GoldStarClinics.

Horse Rules and Regulations

A. Horse Inspection

- Championship horses must be stabled in official competition stabling on the show grounds where the championship is being held. Horses must be in their assigned horse show stabling at least one hour prior to the horse inspection, and horses must remain on the grounds until the completion of their Championship.
- 2. Horses competing in the Championship may not compete in any other class at the same horse show after the Official *horse inspection* has taken place.
- 3. All Championship horses must be presented at the mandatory horse inspection by the athlete or designated representative. The horse inspection will be held not more than 24 hours prior to the start of the First Individual Qualifying Class. The exact time and location will be included in the prize list and schedule for each championship.
- 4. A designated representative for the horse must be present at the *horse inspection*
- 5. Each horse must be presented with its entry number **and current negative Coggins.**Following the official horse inspection, the assigned back number must accompany the horse at all times when it is out of its stall and must be visible on the stall door when the horse is in its stall.
- 6. Horses not accepted at the horse inspection will have the opportunity to be re-presented once prior to the First Individual Qualifying Class.
- 7. If a horse is not accepted at the initial horse inspection, the horse may not participate in the Championship Training Session if it is held prior to the re-inspection. Horses not accepted at there-inspection will not be allowed to compete in the Championships. Horses may not participate in any concurrently held competition during which the Championship is held on the same grounds for a period of 48 hours following the horse inspection. (GR914.3)

B. Tack/Equipment

USEF Rules: USEF rules will govern these Championships *(JP 111).* Additionally, please pay particular attention to the specifics listed below:

1. Martingales

- Only running martingales used in a conventional manner are permitted in the Platinum Championships. (JP111.1b)
- The use of any other type of martingale will be cause for elimination from that Championship class. Exception: Irish Martingales may be used.
- 2. Draw reins and German Martingales may only be used when schooling. No other headset devices (chambon, etc.) are permitted in any class, and cable or metal tie downs are prohibited. (JP111.4) The use of Draw Reins is permissible during awards presentations and victory gallops

3. **Boot Regulations. Refer to USEF Rule JP 111.5.**

Athlete Rules and Regulations

- 1. Although an athlete is not prevented from competing on another horse during the Championship week, there will be no waiting for that athlete during the Championship classes. If an athlete is not immediately available in the order, the athlete will be scratched from that Championship class.
- 2. For the Order of Go for classes with non-Platinum and Platinum horses entered, the Platinum horse must be ridden first.
- 3. Failure to enter the ring within one minute of being called incurs elimination. The time limit for entering the ring must be enforced by management. (JP137.2)
- 4. Only the competing athlete may be mounted on the Championship horse after the official horse inspection.
- 5. Riders' Meeting: There will be a **mandatory** riders' meeting and Show Jumping Athlete Pathway Orientation presentation. The time and location will be included in the prize list and schedule.
- 6. The draw for the Team-Order of Go will take place at the Riders' Meeting. Teams will be determined two weeks prior to the Championship.

A. Schooling

• USEF Jumper Schooling Rules will be in effect throughout the competition (JP 103).

CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULE

There are two format options under which the Championships may be conducted. Host management may choose the option that they feel will work best for the Championship, always keeping the welfare of the horses and athletes as the primary consideration.

Championship Schedule

1.30/135m Junior/Amateur/Professional Championship; spreads up to 1.45M

1.40-1.45m Junior/Amateur/Professional Championship; spreads up to 1.55m

- The Speed Class and the Grand Prix are overlay competitions for the Platinum Championship Athlete/Horse Combinations. Championship ribbons will be given in addition to the show class awards and prize money.
- The speed is 350m/m.

OPTION ONE - Three Day/ Round Format

- A. DayOne (First Round of the Team Championship and First Individual Qualifying Class)
 - Specifications: The class will be conducted under Table II, Section 1. Faults and time. (JP 146.2) The results of this class will be decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. Horses with clear rounds or

equal faults are classified according to their time taken to complete the course. Athletes eliminated or retiring from the course for any reason shall receive a score equal to 20 faults more than the highest penalized competitor in that round **that completed the course and received a score.**

- 2. Individual Classification: Faults **and time** from Round One will be carried forward to the Individual Standings and into Round Two of the Team Championships on Day Two. Ties for non-medal positions in the Individual Final will be determined by the time taken on Day One.
- 3. Start Order: The draw for the team start order for the Team Championship will occur at the Riders' Meeting. The order of the individuals on a team will be determined by the Chefs and given to the USHJA representative at the Riders' Meeting. *Teams of three will start with their first rider in* the second rotation.
- 4. Round One for the 1.30/1.35m Platinum Championship *may* be an overlay class with the horse show's regular 1.30m speed class. Table II.1
- 5. Round One for the 1.40/1.45m Platinum Championship *may* be an overlay class with the horse show's regular 1.40m speed class. Table II.1
- 6. All Platinum Championship competitors will go first in the start order of the Final Individual class if held as an overlay class. Riders will compete in a drawn order. in the order drawn at the Riders Meeting.
- 7. Class Awards: Ribbons will be awarded through 8th place. Prize money: 20% of the sections prize money will be paid through 8th as follows: 30%, 22%, 15%, 10%, 7%, 6%, 5%, 5%. This prize money is in addition to the prize money offered in the overlay class.
- B. DayTwo (Second Round of the Team Championship/Second Individual Qualifying Class)
 - 1. Specifications: The Team Championship is a two round format held over two days. Round two also serves as the second Qualifying Class for the Individual Final. The competitors will be scored under a modified Table II.
 - 2. Scoring:
 - The Second Round of the Team Championship is open only to athlete/horse combinations that have started (whether eliminated or not) in the First Individual Qualifying Class (Day One).
 - Athletes eliminated or retiring from the course for any reason shall receive a score equal to 20 faults more than that received by the highest penalized competitor in that round.
 Only the *top* three scores of each team from *rounds one and two* will count toward the team's *final* score.
 - The winning team will be the team with the lowest combined scores from the two rounds.
 - Any teams tied for a medal shall jump-off. The Chefs d'Equipe will select one member from their team for the jump off.
 - If jump-offs for multiple medals are required, the jump-off for the bronze medal will occur
 first.
 - Placing of teams tied below medal positions will be decided by the combined times from the three highest place riders on a team from Day One.
- 3. Start Order: The starting order of teams will be the reverse order of team scores from the first round (Day One). Any teams tied will go in the order of their first round drawn order.

- Athletes competing as individuals will compete in drawn order in the first round and first
 in the second round of the Team Competition. The second-round order for Individual
 competitors will be based on reverse order of scores from the first round.
- 4. Class Awards: Medals will be awarded to the Gold, Silver, and Bronze teams, ribbons will be awarded through 3rd place. Gold team must ride for ribbons, Silver and Bronze teams will enter the ring on foot for a podium presentation. Prize money: 15% of the section's prize money will be paid to the Gold, Silver and Bronze winning teams. Prize money will be paid through 3rd as follows: 50%, 30%, 20% and divided equally among the team's members. Additionally, ribbons will be awarded through 8th to the individual class placings after round one and round two of Team Competition (Day Two). Prize money: 15% of the sections prize money will be paid through 8th to the individual class placings (Day Two) as follows: 30%, 22%, 15%, 10%, 7%, 6%, 5%, 5%. Only faults from the 2nd Individual Qualifier will be considered. Ties for individual placing will first be broken by the faults from the first round of Team Competition on Day One. If Ties remain, the time from day one will be used.

C. Day Three (Individual Final)

- 1. Specifications: The competition will conclude with the Individual Final on the third day. It will be scored under Table II Section 2 and held over one round. The top 15 athlete/horse combinations based on the cumulative scores from the first and second individual qualifying classes, including ties for 15th place, are eligible to compete. They must have not been eliminated in either of the two rounds of the competition. The list of the top 15 will be posted and distributed as soon as feasible after the Team Competition concludes and medals are awarded. Following this posting, if one or more of the qualified athlete/horse combinations is unable to start in the Individual Final, the combination will not be replaced.
- 2. The Individual Final for the 1.30/1.35m Platinum Championships may be an overlay with a Regional Standard Grand Prix Class. Individual Final Participants are eligible for prize money offered in the Championship as well as in the Grand Prix or featured classic if the overlay class is entered.
- 3. The Individual Final for the 1.40/1.45m Platinum Championships may be an overlay on the Grand Prix class. The horse show's Grand Prix or featured classic held at 1.40/1.45m, may serve as the Individual Final. Participants are eligible for prize money offered in the Championship as well as in the Grand Prix or featured classic if the overlay class is entered.
- 4. Start Order: The start order will be the reverse order of a riders' total scores incurred in the first and second individual qualifying classes. In the event of equality of scores, the result of the first qualifying class will decide, with a lower placing athlete/horse combination going before a higher placing competitor.
- 5. All athlete/horse combinations participating in the Platinum Championship will compete before non-Platinum athlete/horse combinations entered in the Grand Prix or featured classic.

- 6. Jump-Off: In the case of a tie for an individual medal, there will be a jump-off, with the jump-off going in the same order as in the Individual Final. Ties for medal position in the 1.30/1.35m or the 1.40/1.45m Platinum Championship will jump off before the Grand Prix jump-off or featured classic.
- 7. Class Awards: Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals provided by the USHJA will be awarded to the top three individuals, along with ribbons to 8th and other specified prizes or prize money as may be specified by the organizers and the USHJA. Top **3** overall must ride for ribbons. Gold, Silver, and Bronze Individuals must stay for a podium presentation. The Individual Medal winners will be invited to participate in one of the USHJA Gold Star clinics. Please find the most updated information about the USHJA Gold Star Clinic at. ushja.org/GoldStarClinics. Prize money: 50% of the section's prize money will be paid to medal winning individuals as follows: Gold 50%, Silver 30%, Bronze 20 %.

ZONE 3 CROSS-ENTRY RESTRICTIONS 2022 QUICK REFERENCE

Full Zone Rules are available at www.ushja.org and will be available in the horse show office. Please note the following Zone 3 Cross-Entry Restrictions:

ADULT-AMATEUR HUNTER

Riders: A rider in the Adult Amateur section is not eligible to compete in any class where fence heights exceed 3'3" with the exception of the Children's/Adult Jumpers and the USHJA National Hunter Derby. Riders may cross enter on a different horse between the Adult Amateur Hunter and the 3'3" Amateur Owner section if the rider owns the horses (not withstanding GR1108, a leased horse is not permitted) he or she is showing in both sections

Horses: Horses entered in Adult Amateur Hunter sections may not compete in the Amateur Owner Hunter sections at the same competition.

Horse and Rider Combination: The horse-and-rider combination is restricted from showing in both Amateur Owner and Adult Amateur Hunter sections at the same show.

LOW ADULT HUTER HORSE

Rider: Riders may not cross enter into any class or section at the same competition where fences exceed 2'9" (Exception: 3'0" Equitation).

ADULT-AMATEUR JUMPER

Rider: Low Adult Amateur Jumper riders may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m at the same competition. High Adult Amateur Jumper rider is not eligible to compete in any jumper class above 1.15m except equitation classes at the same competition.

Horse/Pony: n/a

Horse and Rider Combination: Low Adult Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the High Adult Amateur Jumpers at the same show. Low Adult Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High are offered. High Adult Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the Low Adult Amateur Jumpers at the same show. High Adult Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High are offered.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER HORSE

Rider: A rider in the Children's Hunter section is not eligible to compete in classes where fences exceed 3'3" (exception: age group Equitation, Medal classes, Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper, Pony Jumper and the USHJA National Hunter Derby).

Horses: Horses may not cross enter into any Junior Hunter Class at the same competition.

Horse and rider combination: n/a

LOW CHILDREN'S HUNTER HORSE

Rider:Riders may not cross enter at the same competition into the Children's Hunter, Pony Hunter or any class/section where fences exceed 2'9" (Exception: 3'0" Equitation).

CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY

Rider: Rider must not show over 3'0" at the same show.

Pony: Ponies may not show in any Regular or Green Pony Hunter rated section.

Combination: n/a

CHILDREN'S JUMPER

Rider: Low Children's Jumper riders may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m at the same competition. High Children's Jumper rider is not eligible to compete in any jumper class above 1.15m except equitation or Pony Jumper classes at the same competition.

Horse/Pony: n/a

Horse and Rider Combination: Low Children's Jumper horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the High Children's Jumpers at the same show. Low Children's Jumper horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High are offered. High Children's Jumper horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the Low Children's Jumpers at the same show. High Children's Jumper horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High are offered.





FEI COMPETITORS IMPORTANT INFORMATION

For FEI class information, entry fee and class specifications see FEI section definite schedules at www.fei.org. The FEI Definite Schedule supersedes any information regarding FEI classes/competitions that is printed in this prize list.

Exhibitors are responsible for having their Federations declare their horses for the FEI competition BEFORE the close of entries as listed in the FEI Definite Schedule each week. Defininite entries must be made to your Federation by the Thursday prior to the competition week unless otherwise stated in the Schedule. This Federation weekly declaration is the automatic nomination into the Jog. The Horse Show Office will determine the entries for each and every FEI week based solely off of the Definite Entries submitted on the FEI Entry System for that week. The athlete must manually withdraw any horse he/she does not plan to show before the jog to avoid paying the Late Withdrawal Fee as indicated in the FEI Schedule. Proper entries and withdrawals in the Jog are the sole responsibility of the athlete. We ask that you only declare the number of horses that are allowed each week. We will allow substitutions made by Federations up until 1 hour prior to the Jog/Horse Inspection.

Class Declarations must be done in the Horse Show Office each week on an official Add/Scratch sheet or online no later than 4:00pm the day before the class is held unless otherwise noted. Declarations made after that time may be accepted by Management only and, if accepted, will result in that horse going first in the order (draw) in the competition in question.

FEI STABLING: Please notify the Stabling Office each week BEFORE the Jog/Horse Inspection/stabling time to secure your stall location. FEI Entry Fee includes one stall. Additional FEI stalls, if available, are \$350 per additional stall per week. Stables will be open to receive horses per the FEI Definite Schedule. All horses being admitted to FEI Stabling must have completed the FEI temp records via FEI APP. Any early arrivals must be approved by the Stabling Manager. All horses living in FEI stabling, whether showing or not, must obey all FEI Rules.

FEI JOG: Please check FEI draft schedules for official jog times. Any changes to the FEI Jog/Horse Inspection will be posted in the FEI area and the Horse Show Office. Both horse and rider must be current FEI members in order to present at the Jog/Horse Inspection.

Credentials are required for entrance to the FEI Compound at all times. Credentials are signed out by the FEI Office in the FEI Compound. Five passes will be issued per horse: Rider (1), Trainer of record signing the entry blank (1), Groom (1), and Owner of record as listed in the passport (2).


