**CONSIGNMENT FORM – September 24, 2022 Sale**

I am entering the animal described below for auction to be held by Carolina Horsemen's Connection Sale at Tryon International Equestrian Center, 25 International Boulevard, Mill Spring, NC 28756. **Pre-payment of consignment fee is NOT required and will be deducted from your check on sale day.** Consignors paid day of sale.

**Terms & Conditions:** The entry fee is \$200 and commission is 10% of the final hammer price if sold. Stalls are \$10 each and will include ONE bag of shavings. There is no "No Sale" fee. **The entry fee will be forfeited on each animal cataloged and/or advertised if said animal is withdrawn from the sale prior to the sale without a veterinarian's statement.** All animals are assumed to be sound unless otherwise stated by consignor. All known lameness, cribbing, weaving, unsoundness of eyes or wind, and presence of "parrot" or "monkey" mouth **MUST be announced.** The sex of the animal will be as described on consignment form. Consignor agrees that a gelding is NOT a ridgeling and that a colt or intact male 18 months of age or older does possess 2 testes descended into the scrotum at time of sale. Title of the animal is free from all adverse claims of ownership, possession, or use and consignor agrees to defend title against all claims. Sale management is not responsible for buyer or consignor misunderstanding. All guarantees made are between the consignor and buyer. Sale management acts as an agent only. **A \$250 penalty will be charged in addition to entry fee forfeiture for any animal withdrawn from the sale without a valid veterinarian's statement.** Once consigned, it is expected that your horse will be present at the sale. Selling prior to the sale is strictly prohibited. A current negative Coggins (12 months) is **REQUIRED.** **CONSIGNMENTS MUST BE RECEIVED BY SEPTEMBER 5<sup>TH</sup>!**

## **Set yourself up for SUCCESS!**

We do not place limits on footnotes so please include as much information as you wish! We do reserve the right to edit for grammar & spelling and will include additional pedigree notes of interest where appropriate. If your horse has a show/earnings record then by all means, include this in your submission! HEIGHT is important! We have a HUGE online buyer base and they cannot distinguish height accurately on camera.

**PHOTOS:** We cannot stress enough how important GOOD photos are when it comes to marketing your horse. Take the time to do it right! Professional photos are always best but you can absolutely take your own photos. Make sure your horse is clean/groomed and if tacked, that your tack is properly fitted & in good order. Stand your horse up, square or close to square, enlist a helper to “get ears up” (props like squeak toys & stick horses work great), and pay attention to lighting and background. You’ll want the sun BEHIND the person taking the photo and make sure the background behind your horse is uncluttered. Think of it like you’re putting your horse on a dating website – he/she needs to look his/her best! You can take some pretty amazing photos with your phone if you just take the time to do these things. (iPhone users – the “Live” photo feature is handy for those horses who only flick their ears forward briefly!!!) If you prefer to enlist a photographer, we can provide you with contacts in your area!

**VIDEOS:** Good quality, clear video demonstrating what your horse can do is **very strongly recommended**. Not only do we post your videos on your horse’s listing, we will play them on the big screen while your horse is in the ring. YES, the right video makes a HUGE difference! **ALL VIDEOS MUST BE SUBMITTED IN A YOUTUBE OR VIMEO LINK!** If you are unable to do this and need assistance, we will be happy to compile your video clips and put it on YouTube for you but there is a \$50 fee for doing so, payable in advance. Please contact Bridget at 336-904-8903 if this service is needed. **Please, if at all possible, do NOT put copyrighted music on your videos.**
