STABLING RESERVATIONS

How to Order

- Log onto tryon.com or [Showgroundslive.com](http://showgroundslive.com)
- (<http://showgroundsonline.com/how-to-create-an-online-entry/>) - for instructions on how to create an entry.
- Submit an entry with a stall fee added and paid for.
- If you are shipping your horse in for the weekend, add the "Ship In Fee" when entering.
- Tack stalls can be ordered directly onto horses or onto the barn account (which is automatically created) and can be split when you check in for the show.

Welcome Series Pre-Paid Option Available January 20 - March 1, 2023

- For the Welcome Series only, there will be a prepaid horse stall option for \$220. This stall must be ordered and paid for on the entry/horse at the time of booking.
- Prepaid stalls are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- Tack/grooming stalls are not included in this promotion.
- Trainers wishing to buy a block of stalls at the discounted rate should contact the Show Office and be ready with payment for the block of stalls. These stalls will remain on the trainer account and can not be rebilled to other entries.

Cost

- \$250 per Stall, Tack Room, or Grooming Stall.
- Payment on file is required for a stall to be considered reserved.

Deadline

- Stalls are non-refundable after the closing date of each show.
- Stalls are on a first come first served basis. Some weeks will be limited on the number of stalls available.
- If permanent stalls are filled, temporary stalls may be used at the discretion of management.

Cancellations

- Stalls canceled after the closing date are non-refundable: to cancel a stall/entry, please email lbennett@tryon.com and sarpke@tryon.com (Stall fee and scratch fee may apply).

Shavings/Hay

- Shavings and hay can be ordered on each entry, or on the trainer's barn account.
- Shavings and hay can be split when you check in for the horse show.

Move-In

- Stalls are available at 1pm two days prior to the show (ex. if the show starts on Wednesday, stalls are available Monday).
- Early arrival fee will apply to anyone that arrives prior to the indicated move-in time.

Required Health Documents

- The following health documents must be presented with the horse(s) at the gate upon arrival, and also presented to the horse show office in order to pick up numbers:
 - Negative Coggins test within one year
 - Proof of EHV1 and EHV4 vaccinations within 6 months as per USEF rule GR844
 - Out-of-state horses must have a 30-day interstate Health Certificate

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of Tryon Horse Shows, Tryon International Equestrian Center, & Tryon Resort (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of

New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

WARNING: THE TRYON INTERNATIONAL EQUESTRIAN CENTER WELCOME SERIES, TRYON INTERNATIONAL EQUESTRIAN CENTER, ITS MANAGEMENT, OFFICERS, OWNERS, OFFICIALS, AND EMPLOYEES WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ACCIDENT OR LOSS WHICH MAY OCCUR TO ANY EXHIBITOR SPECTATOR, GUEST, RIDER, GROOM, ATTENDANT OR OTHER EMPLOYEE, ANIMAL, VEHICLE, OR EQUIPMENT AT THE SHOW. THIS SHALL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY TO THE SHOW OR SHOW GROUNDS.

The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management, its decision to be final.

Management reserves the right to limit entries in any class, section or division, to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings and rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants. Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Show Management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of the horse show and the facilities at which the horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause. While every effort has been made to avoid mistakes in this publication, the USEF, Tryon Horse Shows, Tryon International Equestrian Center, Equus Events, Inc. and its management and/or employees assume no liability to anyone for errors. Any significant errors or changes will be disclosed to competitors whose entries are accepted upon their acceptance, and otherwise in accordance with USEF rules.

SAFESPORT REMINDER: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the US Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the US Center SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

MICROCHIPS: All horses and ponies must be microchipped in order to be allowed to show. Exempt from this requirement are Walk-Trot and Opportunity entries and those others listed in USEF GR 901.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

SCHEDULES: All Schedules are Tentative and subject to change. Updated schedules and daily schedules are available at www.tryon.com.

PRIZE LISTS: Prize Lists can be found on www.tryon.com website. Hard copies will be mailed on request.

ENTRIES: Entries must be made online by the closing dates in order to avoid a late fee. Faxed, scanned and/or e-mailed entries will not be accepted. All entries must be secured with a credit card.

CLOSING DATES for entries are as follows:

WELCOME 1- MARCH 13, 2023

WELCOME 2- MARCH 20, 2023

WELCOME 3- MARCH 27, 2023

WELCOME 4- APRIL 3, 2023

After the closing date, stall fees are non-refundable. A \$50 Late Fee will apply for all entries not made online by the closing dates. Entries should be submitted via our online entry system at www.tryon.com or www.showgroundslive.com. Back numbers will not be issued without credit card information logged with the Horse Show Secretary. A \$65 Office Fee will be charged to each horse entered into the show to cover adds/scratches, office services, etc. The entry form for each horse must include the following:

- Horse name and complete description
- Complete mailing addresses for owner/trainer/riders
- All mandatory signatures, including legal guardian in the case of a minor exhibitor
- All required organization membership numbers, USEF/USHJA horse registration numbers and microchip numbers
- All horses/ponies on property will be assessed a mandatory \$20 Medical/Vet Services Fee per competition
- Equine Night Security is included in the stall fee
- All riders participating in amateur or adult classes must be in possession of current amateur status issued by USEF, or apply for same at show
- Entries/post entries accepted based on stall availability

SCRATCHES: Horses may be scratched without a veterinarian's certificate by notifying the horse show secretary in writing. Prior to the closing date, all charges will be refunded (except prepaid stall). After the closing date, stalls are non-refundable and horses will be charged a \$65 scratch fee. No refunds to horses entered in classes not shown.

RETURNED CHECKS/DISPUTED CARDS: A \$75 fee will be charged for non-negotiable checks or credit cards declined or disputed for any reason. Entries for future shows may be declined until funds are paid in full. For any trainers, riders, owners, or responsible parties that have disputed a credit card charge or submitted an NSF check, pre-payment will be required for stalls and entries prior to the start of the show.

SHOW INVOICES: All accounts must be closed out by Sunday of each show week. If you do not, you automatically agree to authorize Tryon Horse Shows to charge the credit card on file for all entry fees, stabling fees, association fees, etc. associated with your horse(s) and are subject to a \$10

close out fee per horse. If you dispute a charge made by Tryon Horse Shows, you may not be able to show until the dispute has been resolved. Invoice discrepancies must be reported to the show office within 24 hours of the completion of the last class of the show. After this time invoices are considered finalized.

OFFICE HOURS:

DAY BEFORE FIRST DAY OF SHOW - 8:00AM-4:00PM

SHOW DAYS - ONE HOUR BEFORE FIRST CLASS - 4:00PM

SUNDAY - THE OFFICE WILL CLOSE 30 MINUTES AFTER THE COMPLETION OF THE LAST CLASS.

CLASS DECLARATIONS: Class adds due by 4:00pm the day before the class (except classes with 24-hr check in). Scratches may be made in the office or online before the class starts. Horses not scratched prior to the start of the class will be billed for that class. Hunter Classic entries are due before the start of the 1st round. Management reserves the right to cut off adds to classes prior to 4pm in the event of weather or ring time restrictions.

STALLS: All stalls are non-transferable and remain under the ownership and control of Tryon International Equestrian Center. Permanent 10x12 stalls of wood/metal construction and temporary 10x10 stall of canvas/metal construction with doors. Flooring is rubber mats over stone dust. Stalls are available for \$250. Locking tack stalls are also available at the regular stall price. Stalls are not refundable after the closing date. To ensure stabling as well as your initial bedding/feed orders, please complete an online entry at Tryon.com. Any horse showing in classes that fall under the '24 Hour Rule' must have an unshared, assigned stall and will be assessed a stall fee. Non-stabled horses will pay a \$50 Grounds Fee.

STABLING ARRIVALS: Will be available starting at 1:00 pm the day before Schooling Day. Check schedules for Schooling Day. Any and all requests for early arrival/late departure must be approved by the Stabling Manager. Early arrivals/late departures will incur a charge of \$50 per stall per day (or any portion thereof).

PRIZE MONEY & REFUNDS: Social Security or Federal ID number of owner or alternate prize money recipient are required for prize money to be distributed. No prize money will be applied until Tax ID#s and complete payee names/addresses/W-9's are on file with the Secretary. Prize money will be credited to your show account once a tax ID/W9 is on file. Any overages (over payment or prize money remaining) will be mailed within 30 days of the close of the competition. In the event of unauthorized redeeming of a check, Tryon Horse Shows, LLC will provide check copies to exhibitors and will be held harmless from the collection process. Prize money will not be applied or distributed unless a w-9 with tax ID is on file. For foreign prize money recipients, an 8ben must be submitted. Per US government regulation, 30% of winnings will be withheld on foreign prize money recipients.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

FEI STALLS: Permanent 10x12 stalls of wood/metal construction. One stall per each FEI horse is included in the FEI Event Fee. Additional FEI stalls, if available, are \$350. **FEI STABLING:** Will be available as per FEI draft schedule. Any and all requests for early arrival/late departure must be approved by the Stabling Manager. Early arrivals/late departures will incur a charge of \$50 per stall per day (or any portion thereof). FEI - please refer to FEI page herein.

REQUIRED HEALTH DOCUMENTS: Upon arrival at the main gate, horses must be presented with a negative coggins within one year, proof of EHV1 and EHV4 vaccinations within 6 months, and out-of-state horses must have a 30-day interstate Health Certificate.

SHARPS CONTAINERS: Sharps Containers are available in the barns

TRAINER SPLITS: Trainer Splits are done as a courtesy and must be turned into the Horse Show Office by 12:00 noon on Friday. Any trainer accounts which have not been split, for any reason, will be evenly split on all horses entered into the horse show.

TICKETED SCHOOLING: If time and weather permits, management may make ticketed schooling available for \$30 per round. Back number and a signed entry blank are required. Time limits may apply. Switching riders or horses leaving and returning to the ring are susceptible to being billed for a second round.

LODGING: Please contact our Lodging Department at 828-863-1015 to inquire about available onsite/offsite lodging options, reserve a room, cabin or camper/ RV site or golf cart. All reservations and payment for all reservations must be made directly to the Lodging Department. Campers/RVs/cabins, etc. may NOT be put on show bills, nor split on Trainer Accounts.

MINORS/MINOR EXHIBITORS: Parent(s) or guardian(s) of minors/minor exhibitors shall hold the Horse Show Management and the Facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No child's entry will be accepted or number issued unless entry is signed by a parent or LEGAL guardian. The signature of unrelated persons WILL NOT be accepted. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian, or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt

from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hoverboards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

RINGS: All competition/riding rings have all-weather footing that consists of sand and synthetic material mixture and draining system. Rings 1-4 178'x390' each; Tryon Stadium 310'x250'; Ring 6/7 370'x420'; Ring 8 150'x691'; International Arena 260'x325'; Longeing Area 420'x115'.

COURSES: Management reserves the right to restrict the area of the courtesy circle, if deemed necessary, by a mandatory line ("dotted line") as per HU110.2.

DOGS: Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise contained at all times. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards pursuant to rule GR1301.6. Failure to maintain your dog under control, as defined here, will result in a \$100 fine assessed to the owner. In addition, pursuant to facility regulations, loose dogs will be removed from the show grounds by Animal Control, at the owner's expense and impounded.

PARKING: Fire regulations prohibit all vehicles, including trailers, vans and passenger vehicles from being parked in the stable areas. Vans and trailers will be allowed in the stable area only to load or off-load. PARKING AREAS WILL BE DESIGNATED AND VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AWAY AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.

ANIMAL WELFARE: We require that all horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion and should never be subject to mistreatment. Owners, trainers, riders and grooms, or their agents must use reasonable care in the handling and treatment of their horses whether owned or placed in their care for competition or for any other purpose. At all times, while the horse is on the show grounds,, we will provide for the continuous well-being of the horse by vigorously enforcing the rules of the USEF which pertain to the welfare of the horse. USEF rules defining policy regarding abuse and use of whips will be strictly enforced. No poling, use of bamboo off-set or excessive use of the whip will be tolerated. The well-being of the horse must be considered above the demands of the breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organizers, sponsors or officials. Violators may be subject to penalties pursuant to USEF

rules. IN THE EVENT OF AN ACUTE AND SERIOUS INJURY TO OR ILLNESS OF A HORSE ON COMPETITION GROUNDS WHEN THE OWNER OR TRAINER OF THE HORSE OR AGENT OF THE OWNER IS NOT PRESENT, AFTER REASONABLE EFFORT TO CONTACT THAT INDIVIDUAL HAS BEEN MADE, COMPETITION MANAGEMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH A LICENSED EQUINE VETERINARIAN, MAY AUTHORIZE THE PROVISION OF EMERGENCE VETERINARY TREATMENT OF THE HORSE. IF COMPETITION MANAGEMENT SO AUTHORIZES TREATMENT UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS RULE, COMPETITION MANAGEMENT AND VETERINARIAN ARE NOT LIABLE FOR ANY RESULTING COSTS, DAMAGES, LOSSES, CLAIM OR ACTIONS ARISING DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY FROM THE TREATMENT OF THE HORSE.

ELECTRICAL/FIRE REGULATIONS: All electrical installation and connections must meet all state and county codes. Aisles will be maintained clear for a minimum of six (6) feet wide by eight (8) feet high. No obstructions or projections shall be allowed in the aisles. No Class 1 Flammable liquids such as gasoline are allowed inside the buildings. Cooking is not permitted within the stable area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to dismissal from further participation in the horse show without recourse.

MEASUREMENTS: Measurements will be conducted at 10am on Friday of each show. If an alternate measure time is needed, the exhibitor should schedule this in the show office.

HEADGEAR: All persons when mounted anywhere on the showgrounds are required to wear properly fastened protective headgear. Please refer to GR801.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES/GOLF CARTS: Under North Carolina State Laws and USEF rules, unlicensed drivers are not permitted to operate any motorized vehicles - ATV's, motorcycles, golf carts, etc., on the show grounds. Failure to abide by these regulations will subject the exhibitor to suspension from the horse show. See USEF GR 1301.7.

LIABILITY: Tryon Horse Shows, LLC, Tryon International Equestrian Center, Equestrian Sports Productions, their officials, and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to any exhibitor, spectators, guest, rider, groom, attendant, other employees, animals, or equipment at the events. They are therefore strongly advised to take out third party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events, and to keep that policy up to date.

ADULT-AMATEUR HUNTER

RIDER: A rider in the Adult Amateur section is not eligible to compete in any class where fence heights exceed 3'3" with the exception of the Children's/Adult Jumpers and the USHJA National Hunter Derby. Riders may cross enter on a different horse between the Adult Amateur Hunter and the 3'3" Amateur Owner section if the rider owns the horses (not withstanding GR1108, a leased horse is not permitted) he or she is showing in both sections.

Horses: Horses entered in Adult Amateur Hunter sections may not compete in the Amateur Owner Hunter sections at the same competition.

Horse and Rider Combination: The horse-and-rider combination is restricted from showing in both Amateur Owner and Adult Amateur Hunter sections at the same show.

LOW ADULT HUNTER HORSE

NOMINATING FEE: Nominating Fee for all horses showing in jumper classes held at 1.20m or above, except FEI or otherwise noted. For FEI entries please refer to FEI section and Definite Schedule.

DECLARATIONS: Declarations must be made on the appropriate form in the Horse Show Office or online by 4:00 pm the day before the class is to be held unless otherwise noted. Entries made after the deadline will be placed first in the order of go and will be subject to a late charge in addition to the entry fee. "Day of" adds to classes may not be permitted in some cases or classes.

ORDER OF GO: For national classes that require a drawn order (classes with \$5,000 or more in prize money), the order will be drawn as follows: the horses' names are drawn individually, starting with the first position and then working down. A Computer drawn order may be used for classes with less than \$5000 in prize money.

CLASS TIES: All ties involving first place shall be jumped off. Ties for placings other than first place will be decided by time.

ATTIRE: Coats are required for all classes in the Stadium unless waived by management.

CLASSES: Classes or Classics with fewer than eight entries may be combined or canceled. Classes with fewer than three entries may be canceled or run as "Training" classes with no prize money.

AWARDS: Ribbons 1-8 unless otherwise noted.

CHAMPION AND RESERVE: A minimum of three in each class of a Section to award Section championships if offered. Children's, Adult, and Junior/Amateur sections will be calculated using results from section classes and the Classic. All ties will be broken by results of the Classic (when applicable) or by the final class of the section. No championships will be offered for .80m, .90m, 1.0m and Schooling Jumper Classes

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and 2022 Tryon Horse Shows ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horse natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizer and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY ACT WARNING:

C. D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; all promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractor and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (**Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"**), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fee of any kind or nature ("Liability")) which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.
